# Object Method

An ObjectMethod is a method that must be called relative to a previous constructed object of the class type.  
For example:

# package Telecoms

## ClassMethod new()

## ObjectMethod phone( \$who )

must be called something like this

```
my $mobile = new Telecoms();  
$mobile->phone( "home" );
```

or you can pass the object in as a parameter if you need to:

```
Telecoms::phone( $mobile, "home" );
```
